## **DICA Regional Office opened in Myitkyina [1]**

The Directorate of Investment and Company Administration, under the Ministry of Planning and Finance, opened its regional office in Myitkyina in Kachin State on 10th July 2017, with the goal of providing and facilitating regional investment promotion activities and the incorporation of companies and related business activities.

The opening ceremony was attended by the Speaker of the Regional Hluttaw, Ministers of Kachin State Government, Secretary of the Myanmar Investment Commission and Director General of the Directorate of Investment and Company Administration (DICA), U Aung

Naing Oo, senior officials, and regional departmental heads, members of the Myitkyina Chamber of Commerce and Industry and entrepreneurs.
