The objective of the meetings is to review the 2nd OECD Investment Policy Review of Myanmar, to discuss the FDI linkages to small and medium enterprises (SMEs), and the land

reform process.

The task force members discussed the next steps and timeline. The FDI linkages to small and medium enterprises (SMEs) and the land reform process were discussed at the related meetings.

It was attended by 33 participants including experts from the OECD, representatives from relevant ministries, officials from the DICA and representatives from UMFCCI.
