

Form E-13C | Second notice from Registrar to overseas corporation concerning carrying on business

Section 55(c), Myanmar Companies Law 2017

1. General instructions

Section 55(b) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 states:

“Where the Registrar reasonably believes that an overseas corporation does not carry on business in the Union, it may send to the overseas corporation a notice to that effect and stating that, if no answer showing cause to the contrary is received within 28 days from the date of the notice, a notice will be published in the Gazette with a view to striking the overseas corporation’s name off the register.”

Section 55(c) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 then states:

“Unless the Registrar receives, within 28 days after the date of the notice, an answer to the effect that the overseas corporation is still carrying on business in the Union, it may publish in the Gazette, and send to the overseas corporation a further notice that, at the end of 3 months after the date of the notice, the overseas corporation’s name will, unless cause to the contrary is shown, be struck off the register.”

2. Details of inquiry
